We do this by offering One-on-one literacy tutoring, English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) programs, Citizenship Preparation classes and English and Digital Literacy services for American and foreign-born adults.

Blue Ridge Literacy's Annual Scrabble Tournament Fundraiser is our most important event of the year.

The proceeds from this event will be directly invested into BRL's tutoring, class, and citizenship programs

for over 350 learners representing 42 countries. In past years, our Scrabble tournaments have helped us

raise over \$10,000, with all proceeds used to provide literacy services to hundreds of learners

throughout the region. This year, we want to go even further and host our most impactful event yet.

We are expecting a minimum of 100 attendants at this year's fundraiser.

Blue Ridge Literacy's programs offer English literacy skills that are essential for the success and self-

sufficiency of adult learners. The ability to read, write, and communicate is key to remaining connected

with others, staying healthy, supporting school-aged children, and finding employment. This is even

more pronounced in the case of immigrants and refugees, who often face language barriers and have

inadequate information about available resources.

Our learners work hard to improve their English and digital literacy skills so they can access life-saving

information, verify the credibility of the information they receive, and support their children with school

work. BRL's Programs help bridge our learners' knowledge gap by offering the communication skills they

need in everyday settings and contextualized skills such as health, digital and financial literacy. By

facilitating a successful transition to engaged community members, BRL's services contribute to

interwoven equity.

Recognition for funding organizations

As indicated in Figure 1, our Sponsorship levels come with different incentives and modes of

BLUE RIDGE LITERACY SERVICES AND PROGRAMS

One-on-one Tutoring Program

Blue Ridge Literacy's tutoring program is a unique service to address the literacy needs of American and Foreign-born adults in our community. In this Program, a trained volunteer tutor works with an adult for two hours per week for a minimum of 6 months on literacy skills that are individualized based on the needs and goals of our learners.





Blue Ridge Literacy holds six in-person and online volunteer training workshops every year to recruit and train new literacy volunteers.









English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) Class Programs

Blue Ridge Literacy offers in-person and online English classes for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) at Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced Levels. ESOL Classes take place Tuesdays and Thursdays in three 15-week (60-hours) semesters.

- · Spring Semester: January 5th- April 16th, 2023
- Summer Semester: May 4th- August 17th. 2023
- Fall Semester: September 5th, December 19th, 2023





We offer in-person classes in the mornings from 10:00-12:00 at the BRL office in the main library building in downtown Roanoke. Online classes take place in the evenings, from 6:00-7:30 pm on Zoom.

Integrated English Literacy Services

English and Health Literacy

Blue Ridge Literacy's English and Health Literacy Class program is created in response to the health literacy needs of non-English speaking adult learners. This program combines English-language instruction and health literacy content and is specifically designed for non-English speaking adults with a beginning to high intermediate level of English proficiency. The goal is to familiarize learners with the particular literacy demands of health care settings (e.g., writing, reading, and communicating) so they are better equipped to navigate these settings.







English and Digital Literacy

In FY 21-22 Blue Ridge Literacy started offering English and Digital Literacy Programs using the Northstar Digital Literacy curriculum. Adult learners can take a placement test at Blue Ridge Literacy to test their computer skills, build skills in key areas and demonstrate their computer and digital literacy knowledge by earning certificates and badges.



BRL's English and Digital Literacy programs cover the following areas:

- Essential Computer Skills
- · Essential Software Skills
- · Using Technology in Daily Life

We offer small-group classes, one-on-one tutoring, and self-paced options based on our learners' needs and availability.

Citizenship Preparation Program

Blue Ridge Literacy offers citizenship preparation classes to assist adult learners with the successful completion of their naturalization process. In order to pass the US naturalization interview, lawful permanent residents are tested on their knowledge of US Civics and English skills. In FY 21-22 we added new programs to BRL's Citizenship Preparation Services to address our learners' skill-based needs and naturalization processes.
